



EXCITEMENT MOUNTS FOR THE ADM MAYOR'S CUP CHALLENGE

The Mayor's Cup is an initiative of the Amathole District Municipality that was established in 2005, originally as a crime prevention strategy, and to create more positive outlets for the youth of the district through the promotion of sport. The Mayor's Cup is a knock-out competition between teams from all eight local municipalities within the district playing in various sporting codes.
